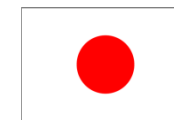

Scholarship for Master's Degree Program in Japan



The Project for Human Resource Development Scholarship by Japanese Grant Aid (JDS) in Mongolia 2016



Objective

JDS is the long-term scholarship project for the Government of Mongolia through the assistance of the Government of Japan. Its objective is to provide Mongolian citizens working mainly in the public sector with opportunities for obtaining master's degree (2-year course) at Japanese universities in order to support the human resource development of the Government of Mongolia, and eventually to extend and strengthen the bilateral relations between Japan and Mongolia. Twenty (20) young government officials and employees of private companies, who are expected to play leadership roles in Mongolia, will be selected for Japanese Academic Year 2017 (enrolment in September or October, 2017).

Eligibility

[Common requirement]

1. Citizens of Mongolia
2. Between age of 25 and 39 as of April 1, 2017
3. Holding a bachelor's degree
4. Has not been awarded any other government scholarship for Master's degree in foreign countries
5. Must not be serving in the Military

[Specific requirement for slot of Public Sector]

6. Currently employed by the Government of Mongolia
7. Minimum of 2-year full time work experience in public sector
8. TOEFL iBT 61 (ITP 500) / IELTS 5.5 or above is preferable

[Specific requirement for slot of Private Sector]

6. Must be a full time employee of private companies which meet one of the following conditions:
 - A) currently has an employer or employee(s) who completed the Basic Business Course of Mongolia-Japan Center for Human Resources Development (MOJC) or completed the Model Company Development, Diagnosis and Guidance Program of MOJC,
 - B) has received loans from JICA's SMEs Development and Environment Protection Two Step Loan (TSL) Project
 - C) involved in the loan work of the TSL Project as Participating Financial Institution (PFI), or
7. Minimum of 5-year full time work experience (including 2-year full time work experience at current company)
8. Must have Japanese Language Proficiency Test N1 level

Fields of Study and Accepting Universities

JDS fellows are required to study under one of these sub-programs and components, which correspond to and deal with the target priority areas and development issues, which were confirmed as being indispensable to the economic and social development of the country.

Allowances for JDS Applicants

All the selection costs will be covered by JDS Project, including:

- (1) Fee for TOEFL ITP and health check-up
- (2) Transport and accommodation allowances for attending interviews in Ulaanbaatar

Scholarship Benefits

JDS is a FULL scholarship program which covers

- (1) Tuition fee at Japanese higher educational institutions
- (2) Air ticket between Mongolia and Japan (round trip)
- (3) Monthly scholarship
- (4) Accommodation allowance in Japan
- (5) Arrival allowance
- (6) Subsidiary allowance (Seminars, Books, Shipping, Medical Insurance, etc.)

Selection Schedule
