Background of CP	<p>In 2011, Timor-Leste established the Strategic Development Plan (SDP), which covers city planning, state planning, transportation, waterworks, environment, waste disposal, etc., and has promoted development projects in each sector to realize the SDP. However, many ministries and departments are dependent on foreign advisors and support from donors for formulation of the development plans, strategies, and policies that serve as a basis for promoting such development projects. This cannot be avoided considering the circumstances of Timor-Leste, that it requires rapid implementation of development projects in the launch phase of the state. Henceforth, the country needs to be responsible for a series of work, such as identification and analysis of development issues, contemplation and formulation of policy measures and their implementation. Thus far, priority has been given to development projects. Hereafter, Timor-Leste has to contemplate and consolidate the following issues and formulate policies to deal with them on their own: efficient budget management within the limited revenue, who and which organization should be implemented, improvement in technological capabilities and in quality assurance, ways of dealing with new issues, and so on.</p>
