Background:		
<p>In its Seventh Five Year Plan (2016-2015), the Government of Bangladesh stipulates that preparation and appropriate operation of a legal system aimed at good governance is one of the most important challenges. Further, reforms (improvement) that focus on legal and administrative systems including intellectual property rights issues are also considered to be essential in order for public investments and policies to attract private investments.</p> <p>With respect to the Law of the Sea, Bangladesh does not have a long history of studying it; thus, human resource development in this field is an urgent task.</p> <p>Considering the need for the creation of legal frameworks for the promotion of the expansion of Japanese companies into Bangladesh and implementation of development projects, it is important to train staffs who can take the initiative in policy-making in this field. Therefore, it is significant that JDS Project covers this field.</p>
