<b>Direction of Study (Background of CP)</b>	<p>In addition to continuous effort on turnaround of healthcare system by the government since the end of conflict in 1991, thanks to the impact of economic growth and aid from donor countries, Cambodia's basic index on maternal and child health is making remarkable improvement recently.</p> <p>However, issues such as shortage / insufficient quality of healthcare personnel, malnutrition especially in the rural areas, or poor access to medical services still remain and thus more improvement is needed compared to the surrounding countries. Moreover, in view of achieving Universal Health Coverage (UHC) advocated in the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs), enhancement of medical security system turns out to be the urgent issue for Cambodia.</p> <p>Under this circumstances, it is necessary to foster human resources those who can design development plans and policies, or who can properly examine and manage the plan and progress, draw up and carry out the operational and maintenance plans in order for health system strengthening.</p>
