| Purpose of Study (Background of CP) | <p>Although Tajikistan has continued to grow steadily since 2000 after the Civil war that continued from 1992 to 1997 after independence, the gap between urban and rural areas is widening. In addition, the economic structure has not changed due to growth such as diversification of industries and high added value. Approximately 30% of GDP depends on migrant workers' remittances overseas, and the environment is still greatly affected by fragile economic structures. Tajikistan's "National Development Strategy 2016-2030" aims to improve the living standard of the people through sustainable economic development, aims to overcome the vulnerability of the economy, improve the added value of industry, promote import substitution and export, and process domestic agricultural products. It is said that it will focus on employment creation, especially in rural areas, by supporting entrepreneurs and SMEs in the manufacturing field.</p> <p>Japan's assistance policy for Tajikistan has a basic policy of "Institutional Building for Sustainable Economic Development" and JICA has set "Improvement of Economic and Industrial Development Bases" as a new priority field, and works on "improving the business environment for employment promotion". As a complement to this, the JDS project requires young administrative officers and practitioners who can formulate and implement macroeconomic policies, fiscal policies, monetary policies, economic development policies such as revitalization of the private sector, and related system construction. Expected to grow.</p> <p>JDS project is expected to support capacity building of the government officials who can design and carry out Macroeconomic policy, economic forecast, budget system, fiscal policy (taxation system), monetary policy, external debt management, international accounting standard system, trade, improvement of investment environment, revitalization of private sector, etc. for the promotion of sustainable economic development.</p> | |
